British Gymnastics has advised that all Parents/Guardians receive and accept the following code of conduct. We are fully committed to safeguarding and promoting the well being of all our members and your support is greatly appreciated.

1. Encourage your child to learn the rules of the gym and participate within them.
2. Discourage challenging/arguing with officials.
3. Publicly accept official's decisions.
4. Help your child to recognise good performance, not just results.
5. Set a good example by recognising good sportsmanship and applauding the good performance of all.
6. Never force your child to take part in sport.
7. Always ensure your child is dressed appropriately for the activity and has plenty to drink.
8. Keep the club informed if your child is ill or unable to attend sessions.
9. Endeavour to establish good communications with the club, coaches and officials for the benefit of all.
10. Stress any concerns or complaints about the club through the correct channels.
11. Use correct and proper language at all times.
12. Never punish or belittle a child for poor performance or making mistakes.
13. Always collect your child promptly at the end of each session.
14. Support your child's involvement and help them to enjoy their sport.
